Seminar format

The Seminar will include invited lectures by distinguished biostatisticians and informaticians from various countries. Beside these lecturers there will be enough time for contributed paper sessions. We especially invite young scientists to submit papers on original work. Part of the sessions will be didactic in character and will be addressed particularly to medical researchers.

The last Seminar was attended by about 80 participants.

Time and location

The Seminar will take place in Warsaw, Poland, 19-21 June 2008 in the buildings of the Institute of Biocybernetics and Biomedical Engineering of the Polish Academy of Sciences and the International Centre of Biocybernetics, located in the new research centre comprising several institutes and hospitals (*Ochota Campus*). Institute of Biocybernetics and Biomedical Engineering is conveniently located 10 min car drive from the airport and close to the central railway station.

Fee and accommodation

The Seminar is organised without fee. The costs of the Seminar are covered by the Polish Academy of Sciences.

Participants can be accommodated in Warsaw hotels (costs of accommodation are not covered by the organisers).

The Preliminary Programme will be distributed about May 31, 2008.

Contributions

An extended abstract in English of the length up to 6 pages, clearly stating the purpose of the poster presentation, results and conclusions should be submitted to the Seminar Secretariat. The title and name(s) of the author(s), affiliations, postal and e-mail addresses and fax number should be included. Received abstracts will be reviewed. The accepted abstracts will be published in the seminar proceedings and research results will be presented at the conference during poster session.

A special issue of the journal *Biocybernetics and Biomedical Engineering* will be devoted to selected papers from the Seminar.
