#### Description

The three short courses set up on a laboratory learning environment will include case studies and practical sessions on network analysis and biostatistics in medicine and the pharma industry – the current and future challenges.

#### **Biographic Details**

David W Warne, BSc, MSc, PhD, CStat

Consultant biostatistician, with more than 20 successful years experience in clinical development, directing the statistical aspects of phase 1-4 clinical trials, expert in process and quality management, with a long lasting collaboration in leading positions with Pharma companies as Serono (1995-2006, Geneva) and Merck Serono (2007-2013, Geneva).

Dr. David W Warne helped create successful submission packages for health authorities in US, EU and Japan, designed and ran studies with innovative statistical methodology, provided the statistical perspective in cross-functional teams working on process improvement. He had an important role in the industry review of health authority statistical and clinical guidance documents, e.g. (Draft Guidance for Industry Guidance on Adaptive Design Clinical Trials for Drugs and Biologics [FDA, 2010]; Draft Guidance for Industry on Non-Inferiority Clinical Trials [FDA, 2010]; Guideline on non-clinical and clinical development of similar biological medicinal products containing recombinant human follicle stimulating hormone (r-hFSH) [EMA, 2010]). During his career, Dr. Warne was involved in outsourcing work to Japan, Africa, India and Europe, and participated in a number of audits in Australia and Europe.

After over 20 years of dedicated work in ISCB, since 1992 as Executive Committee Member, Newsletter Editor, Webmaster, Secretary, Vice-President, Dr. David W Warne will soon become ISCB President for 2015-16.

#### Anca Vitcu, PhD

Associate Professor, collaborate with the Faculty of Computer Science, "Alexandru Ioan Cuza" University of Iasi since 2002 on training and research programmes approaching topics like stochastic processes, complex adaptive systems modeling, social network analysis. Dr. Vitcu had a lengthy and fruitful cooperation as sampling and data analysis adviser with UN Agencies (WHO (Geneva), UNICEF (Bucharest), UNECE (Geneva), UNDP (Bucharest)), national and international non-governmental organizations (Romanian National Institute of Statistics (Bucharest), National Institute of Public Health (Bucharest), International Center for Migration, Health and Development (Geneva)), Governmental Institutions (Romanian Parliament (Commission for European Integration), Institute for Research and Crime Prevention (Ministry of Interior)) being involved in key projects focused on social and epidemiological related issues. Since 2010 she is coordinating the Romanian National Group of the International Society for Clinical Biostatistics, and since 2011 is acting as Secretary of the ISCB National Groups Subcommittee.

Associate Professor at the Faculty of Medicine ("Lucian Blaga" University, Sibiu), Head of the Medical Informatics and Biostatistics Department, member of the European Federation of Medical Informatics and network coordinators of the Romanian National Group of the International Society for Clinical Biostatistics, dr.
